Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

February 21, 2017

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jerry Radke, County Attorney Joel Jay and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye. The minutes of the February 7, 2017 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. The Highway Supervisor position will be filled at the March 7 Commissioner meeting. It was moved by Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Fischer, to appoint Kelly Kopetzky as interim highway supervisor initiate a pay increase to Kelly Kopetzky in the amount of \$18.00, effective February 16. Motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, to pay Office Administrator Chauntine Snell in the amount of \$14.60 per hour effective February 16. Discussion was held regarding the purchases being made by road laborers. It was reiterated by the Board that they wanted purchases to be made locally. Interim Highway Supervisor Kelly Kopetzky and Office Administrator Chauntine Snell were instructed to make sure only authorized purchases were made and locally if at all possible.

Jeff Ortgies reported on the activities of the City Lake Board. On behalf of the Chappell Lake board, he reported that during a meeting held on Friday with the Lake board, it was determined that the Department of Environmental Quality would like to review the plans prior to any projects begin. In the future, a request for assistance in the form of manpower/equipment may be made. The Commissioners encouraged him to return after finding out exactly what type and when the assistance may be needed.

Veterans Service Officer Ron Jacobs met with the Board to discuss the appointment of the new Veteran's Service Officer. No correspondence has been received from the State Veteran's Board.

Motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, to enter into executive session at 9:10 a.m. with Commissioners Fischer, Klingman, Radke and County Attorney Joel Jay, to discuss a personnel issue. Radke, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke, to resume the regular meeting at 10:00 a.m. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, to allow Kimball County to join the Inter-local Agreement for Emergency Management, Region 21. Radke, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye.

Sheriff Scott DeCoste reported on activities within his office.
