



# Deuel County Board Minutes



## Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

May 2, 2017

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jerry Radke and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye. The minutes of the April 18, 2017 meeting and the April 20 special meeting, were approved upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye.

Deuel County Clerk/Clerk of the District Court Polly Olson presented a report of fees collected for the month of January, 2017 in the amount of \$8,182.50. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing.

Motion was made at 8:32 a.m. by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Radke to enter into the Board of Equalization to hear tax list corrections. Klingman, aye, Fischer, aye, Radke, aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, to reconvene the regular meeting at 8:34 a.m. Radke, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye.

Office Administrator Chauntine Snell and Highway Supervisor Kelly Kopetzky reported on activities within the Highway Dept. The right of way agreements will be updated and presented for approval. One bid was received from Figgins Construction of Red Cloud, Nebraska for the armor coating project in the amount \$135,731.20 (\$125,551.36 for Wheatland Drive and \$10,179.84 for the golf course road), it includes double chip sealing at \$2.41 per square mile. It was moved by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke, to approve the bid, with the understanding that the project will be completed by July 1, 2017. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye.

It was moved by Commissioner Fischer second of Commissioner Radke, to enter into executive session to review the applications for the road laborer position at 8:55 a.m. with Commissioners Klingman, Fischer, Radke, County Attorney Jay, County Clerk Olson, Highway Supervisor Kopetzky and Office Administrator Snell present. It was moved by Commissioner Fischer, second of Klingman, to resume the regular meeting at 9:05 a.m. Radke, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye.

It was moved by Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman, to hire Ryan Heidemann as road laborer at \$15.00 per hour starting May 3, 2017. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye.

County Noxious Weed Supt. Cris Burks met with the board to report on the activities within the Deuel County Noxious Weed program.

Jeff Ortgies presented a propane contract from Frenchman Valley Coop. Last year was \$4,500.00 and the county used it all. The board discussed the options available. It was moved by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke to approve the contract at \$1.10. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye. He will prepare a contract for signatures.

Deuel County Sheriff Scott DeCoste presented a report of fees collected in the amount of \$223.30 for the month of April, 2017. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing. Motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Radke to enter into executive session at 9:58 a.m. to discuss a personnel issue with Commissioners Klingman, Radke, Fischer, County Sheriff DeCoste and County Attorney Jay.
