Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

May 16, 2017

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jerry Radke and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye. The minutes of the May 2, 2017 meeting were approved with the correction that the cost for milling in the contract with Figgin Construction will be 2.41 per square yard not 2.41 per square mile for chip sealing as the clerk published in the Chappell paper, upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye.

Office Administrator Chauntine Snell and Highway Supervisor Kelly Kopetzky reported on activities within the Highway Dept. Tony Armer presented two proposals for services as contracted highway supt. The board will review the options.

Kamy Jeppson-Haugenstun, owner of the Rusty Bucket requested permission to provide KENO, operating under the County's license. Upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, the Rusty Bucket will be allowed to operate KENO under the Deuel County license. Radke, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye.

Garrett Unrein, USDA Predator Control specialist met with the board to present the annual predator control contract. Upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke, the contract was approved. The five year service agreement was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Fischer. Radke, aye, Klingman, aye, Fischer, aye.

Custodian Jim Hinnegan met with the board to discuss moving the tree in the section of the sidewalk in the corner of the courthouse property. Mr. Hinnegan was given permission to move the tree to an area that will allow the tree to grow.

Sheriff Scott DeCoste reported on activities within his department. The Inter-local Law Enforcement Agreements were approved in the amount of \$88,000.00 for Big Springs and \$88,000.00 for Chappell, upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. Chad Svboda of Strong Financial met with the board to discuss the 2017 Blue Cross Blue Shield Blue Pride rates for Small Group Membership. The Small Group BCBS rates will be \$777.88 for the single coverage versus \$701.19 last year. Dental insurance will be as follows, (at the employee's expense) single \$31.01, Employee and family \$77.83, Employee and Spouse \$59.62, Employee & Children \$50.52. Upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman, the county will renew the contract with Strong Financial, Blue Pride for small groups. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye.
