Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

July 6, 2017

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jerry Radke, County Attorney Joel Jay and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. Custodian Jim Hinnegan reported that the roof of the Courthouse was damaged during the hail storm on June 7 and he also presented an estimate to provide a chair lifts to each floor.

Deuel County Sheriff Scott DeCoste reported on activities within his office. He reported fees collected in his office for the month of June in the amount of \$279.96. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing.
