The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairman of the Board Steve Fischer, Commissioner Bill Klingman, Commissioner Jerry Radke, County Attorney Joel Jay and Deputy County Clerk Marilyn Morgan. The meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Notice of the meeting was published in the Chappell Register as required by law. Reference was made to the Revised Open Meeting Laws (August 2015) posted at the entrance to the meeting room. County Clerk/Clerk of the District Court Polly Olson report of fees collected for the month of August, 2017 in the amount of \$3,162.48. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing.

Veteran's Service Officer Alex Herrera met with the board and recommended the appointment of Larry McCroden to the County Veteran's Service Board to fill the vacancy created by the death of Murl Mauser of Big Springs. He also discussed funds held by the County in the Veteran's Aid. An accounting of how the funds were obtained, which were transferred to the County as per request of the Auditor has not been clear, however, the sale of the American Legion building was in the amount of \$3,500.00 upon record.
