



# Deuel County Board Minutes



Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

November 21, 2017

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jerry Radke, County Attorney Joel Jay and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye. The minutes of the November 7, 2017 meeting upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Fischer. Klingman, abstain, Radke, aye, Fischer, aye.

Tony Armer, on behalf of contracted Highway Supt. Mark Manelli; and Highway Supervisor Kelly Kopetzky reported on activities within the Highway Dept. Plans are being made for the repair of more of the oil roads in the county. Bids will be advertised and detailed in the near future.

A grant application submitted by the Deuel County Fair board for repairs and update to the kitchen facility in the 4-H building to the Buckley Trust, was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Fischer. Radke, aye, Klingman, aye, Fischer, aye.

Sealed bids for a project in the Assessor's office were opened. One from N & D Construction of Julesburg in the amount of \$3,700.00 and one from Reichman Construction of Chappell in the amount of \$3,750.00. Upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, the bid was awarded to Reichman Construction. Radke, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye. Discussion was held regarding updating the water fountains or continuing with Culligan. The fountain on the third floor is in need of repair. The Commissioners indicated that they would like to have the water fountain upstairs repaired. Discussion was also held pertaining to snow removal. It was reported that the snow blower that can be used for snow removal has been repaired.

Resolution 2017-20, the Elected Official Salaries for 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022, was tabled. Commissioner Klingman indicated that he would like discussion related to pay in lieu of health insurance. County Attorney Joel Jay will investigate this topic.
