



# Deuel County Board Minutes



Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

December 19, 2017

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jerry Radke, County Attorney Joel Jay and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. During public comment, concerns were presented that pertained to the re-location of the Chappell Child Care Center, which has been given 60 days to vacate the Miller Memorial Care Center basement, due to the closure of the nursing home.

Tony Armer, on behalf of contracted Highway Supt. Mark Mainelli, Highway Supervisor Kelly Kopetzky, Office Administrator of the Highway Dept. Chauntine Snell reported on activities within the Highway Dept. Discussion was held regarding the type of oil used to armor coat the road south of Chappell.

Sheriff Scott DeCoste reported on the activities within his office. He presented information he obtained from meeting with the 911 board that oversees the communication center in Cheyenne County. Discussion was held regarding the costs that would be associated with the change. The board gave approval to Sheriff DeCoste to proceed in obtaining more detailed information and cost projections if the change would occur.

Discussion was held pertaining to a Panhandle Juvenile Detention Center. Commissioner Radke will continue to go future meetings to gather more information.
