Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

February 6, 2018

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jerry Radke, County Attorney Joel Jay and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye. The minutes of the January 16, 2018 meeting were approved with the correction that Treasurer Bernie Littlejohn presented the 6-month report, as required by law, which was reviewed and accepted for filing but omitted from the minutes, upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye.

Deuel County Clerk, Clerk of the District Court Polly Olson, presented a report of fees collected by her office for the month of January, 2018, in the amount of \$6,976.47. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing.

There was no action for the Board of Equalization.

Assistant Highway Supt. Tony Armer, Office Administrator Chauntine Snell and Highway Supervisor Kelly Kopetzky, reported on activities within the Highway Dept. An Assist grant was received in the amount of \$1,000.00 from NIRMA (County Risk Management Pool). The Snow Removal Plan/Policy was reviewed. Maps will be provided at a later date. Theresa Godfrey met with the Board to discuss the conditions on the county gravel roads and presented a bill for reimbursement due to repairs made to her vehicle. She felt that the damage to her vehicle was a direct result of the large rocks on the road. She suggested that the county consider using the screen to process the gravel that is being used to maintain the roads. The board explained the reason not to use the screen, the maintenance operators are instructed not to leave large rocks on the roads. There is no plan to begin using the screen again at this time. Tony Armer reported that he had inspected County Road 175 as soon as he was informed of the issues and found no problems. No action was taken at this time, the County Clerk is instructed to send the information to the risk management pool adjusters for review.

The One and Six Highway Plan in and for Deuel County was opened at 9:02 a.m. No public comment was received. The plan was reviewed with Assistant Highway Supt. Tony Armer. Upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Radke, the 2018 One and Six Road Plan was approved with the clarification of the gravel and oiled roads included in the plan at 9:25 a.m. Klingman, aye, Fischer, aye, Radke, aye.

Sheriff DeCoste reported on the activities within his office. He presented a report of fees collected for the month of January in the amount of \$273.80. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing.

Updates to the Deuel County Personnel were discussed. A motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman to update the policy to include disclosure from the Nebraska Clean Air Act pertaining to smoking. "The County does not permit smoking in any County building or vehicle. Smoke or smoking means the lighting of any cigarette, cigar, pipe, or other smoking material or the possession of any lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, or smoking material, regardless of its composition." Radke, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye.

Warrants in the amount of 103,893.62 were approved upon motion of Commissioner, second of Commissioner . (Payroll \$32,225.10, Claims \$71,668.52), Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye.
