



# Deuel County Board Minutes



Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

March 20, 2018

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jerry Radke and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye. The minutes of the March 6, 2018 meeting upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye.

There was no action for the board of equalization.

Office Administrator Chauntine Snell, Highway Supervisor Kelly Kopetzky and Assistant Highway Supt. Tony Armer reported on activities within the Highway Dept. Mr. Armer presented the results of the core sample surveys. Bids for the repairs of oiled roads will be approved for publication at the April 3 meeting.

Jeff Ortgies discussed the fuel contract with Frenchman Valley. Last year the county only used 6,000 of the 18,000 contracted fuel. The county used approximately 25,000 gallons of fuel. Motion was made by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke, to approve three, 6,000 gallon fuel contracts, (spring, fall and winter), with Frenchman Valley at \$2.41 per gallon. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye.

Sheriff DeCoste reported on the activities within his office. He also presented a report of fees collected in his office for the month of February, 2018 in the amount of \$141.98. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing.

Veteran's Service Officer Alex Herrera met with the board to discuss the Veteran's Aid Fund. The Veteran's Board members from Big Springs verified that none of funds in the Veteran's Aid fund belongs to the Big Springs VFW. Statutory limitations do not allow that the funds in this account be distributed to different entities. Statutes define how the funds, obtained by tax dollars, can be spent.

Discussion was held regarding the Opioid Litigation Resolution. No action was taken at this time. County Attorney Joel Jay will research what options are available and other firms offering this type of class action representation.

The 911 Radio Communication contract was discussed. Director of the Cheyenne County Emergency Communications Center, Heidi Gillespie, was present to offer information pertaining to the proposed contract with the 911 Center in Sidney. Representatives from the Big Springs Fire Dept. and the Deuel County Sheriff Dept. were present indicating that the desire is to contract with Cheyenne County Emergency Communications Center for 911 services. Motion was made by Commissioner Radke, to transfer radio communications and enter into an inter-local agreement with the Cheyenne County Emergency Communications Center. The Sheriff had increased the 911 budget last year to \$55,000, \$38,000.00 for 911 services. Klingman, second. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye. The effective date would be July 1, 2018. The contract will be signed at a later date, including an amendment to the proposed agreement, listing a specific amount that Deuel County would have to pay instead of a percentage of the budget and with an inclusion that a Deuel County Commissioner would have voting rights on the governing board for the Cheyenne County Communications Center.

Warrants in the amount, and \$61,547.94, were approved upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Radke. (Payroll \$27,380.24, Claims \$34,167.70), Klingman, aye, Fischer, aye, Radke, aye.
