



# Deuel County Board Minutes



Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

April 17, 2018

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jerry Radke and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye. The minutes of the April 3, 2018 meeting upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye.

There was no action for the board of equalization.

Assessor Marica Schievelbein presented the report of assessments practices as prepared by the property tax division, State of Nebraska. No recommendations of change for improvement are made at this time.

Sheriff DeCoste reported on the activities within his office. He also presented a report of fees collected in his office for the month of March, 2018 in the amount of \$191.98. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing. He requested permission to purchase a new vehicle for the Sheriff Dept. to replace a 2013 Charger. He would like to purchase a Ford Pickup from the state bid. The funds will come from the Sheriff Vehicle Sinking Fund and the Federal Forfeiture Fund. Upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman, approval is given to replace the Charger through the state bid process with the majority of the funds coming from the sinking fund and the balance to be funded through the Federal Forfeiture Fund. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye.

Discussion was held regarding the Opioid Litigation Resolution. No action was taken at this time.

Attorney Adam Hoeser, representing Region 1 OHD met with the board and presented an amendment to the inter-local agreement with panhandle counties to disband the inter-local agreement. Upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Fischer, Resolution 2018-3, discontinuing Deuel County participation in the inter-local, was approved.
