



# Deuel County Board Minutes



## Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

August 21, 2018

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jerome Radke, County Attorney Joel Jay and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye. The minutes of the August 7, 2018 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. Fischer, aye, Klingman, Radke, aye. (It is noted that a typographical error was found in the published minutes for the cost of the impound building. The permanent minutes reflect the correct cost of the building as \$25,565.00.)

There was no action for the board of equalization.

Operations of the Highway Dept. were discussed. It was reported that it will cost approximately \$930,000.00 for 3 miles with full depth reclamation to correct the Day Road. This will be decided at a later date in another budget year.

As per state statute 77-3443 (3), budgets and levy requests were received from Chappell Fire District #1 and Big Springs Fire District #2. Motion was made by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke, to deny levy allocation under the County's budget, to Fire District #1 and Fire District #2, due to budget constraints. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye.

Three building permits were presented for approval. The first was for a pole barn located just outside Chappell. Upon motion of commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, the building permit for Freeman for the pole barn was approved. Radke, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye. A building permit requesting a variance to reduce the required acres to be divided was approved for Brethauer upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of commissioner Radke. Klingman, aye, Fischer, aye, Radke, aye. The landowner will be establishing a bed and breakfast, no variance to the zoning is required as the land is currently zoned "open", allowing for this purpose. The last permit deals with an agricultural variance for Duncan. This pertaining to enlarging a shop building that is currently an agricultural business. There is no change to the business or the agricultural zoning. Upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman, this permit was also approved. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye.

County Sheriff Scott DeCoste reported on activities within his office. It was reported that the impound building had been cleaned out Saturday to prepare for the removal. He is in the process of preparing for a "sheriff's sale" of the autos in the impound lot. The new building will be completed by October 15, 2018. New deputy Sheriff Sean Holloway was introduced and sworn in by County Attorney Joel Jay. He reported that the new pickup (to be purchased from the sinking fund), would be ready soon.

Custodian Jim Hinnegan presented a letter of resignation, due to medical issues effective September 4, 2018. Upon motion of Radke, second of Commissioner Fischer, the resignation was accepted with regret. Klingman, aye, Radke, aye, Fischer, aye.

Warrants in the amount of \$90,273.59, were approved upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, (Payroll \$26,132.74 Claims \$64,140.85), Radke, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye.
