Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

September 18, 2018

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jerome Radke, County Attorney Joel Jay and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye. The minutes of the September 4, 2018 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman. County Clerk/Clerk of the District Court Polly Olson presented a report of fees collected in her office in the amount of \$2,278.96 for the month of August, 2018. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing.

Operations of the Highway Dept. were discussed.

The quarterly safety committee meeting was held with the following present: Chairperson Chauntine Snell, Scott DeCoste, Jerry Radke, and Kelly Kopetzky. No accidents were reported on county roads.

County Sheriff Scott DeCoste reported on activities within his office. It was reported that the impound building arrived today.

Leah Christensen of Sandhills Crisis Intervention Program met with the board to request permission to place the small whirly wigs on the courthouse lawn during October, Domestic Violence Awareness Month and a request to have a room to meet with clients. The meeting room at the annex will be offered, with the understanding it can be used during business hours as long as it is not being scheduled for county purposes.

Upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, Resolution 2018-12 authorizing County Treasurer Bernie Littlejohn to issue county Tax Sale Certificates for one-year delinquent Real Estate Taxes. Radke, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye.

C.P.A. Donald Wilson presented an audit report. He reported that the budget request was reduced by \$151,013.93. This is an 8% reduction of the property tax request from last year.
