Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

October 16, 2018

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jerome Radke and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye. The minutes of the October 2, 2018 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman. County Clerk/Clerk of the District Court Polly Olson presented a report of fees collected in her office in the amount of \$4,660.45 for the month of September, 2018. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing.

Mr. John Bender, CEO of Frenchman Valley Cooperative, Inc. had presented a request for refund that were misclassification of holding tanks, the stance of the FVC is that the statutes under 77-1734.01 Section (2) of NRS covers an honest error within 3 years after taxes were due. He is here to address the issue of a refund for taxes paid as a result of an error made by the assessment of the value. No building permit was obtained when the tanks were added to the property in 2013. The Assessor had hired a commercial appraiser to assess the value of the commercial properties in 2016, at which time the tanks were added to the tax rolls as pressurized vessels, the closest classification by the program used for assessment. Change of valuation notices were sent and no protests were filed by FVC. No action will be taken until County Attorney Joel Jay can review the documents and statutes pertaining to the issue.

Operations of the Highway Dept. were discussed. County Highway Supt. Tony Armer presented the 2018 SAR report. Upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke the SAR report was approved as presented. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye.

County Sheriff Scott DeCoste reported on activities within his office. He reported fees collected by his office in the amount of \$504.61 for the month of September, 2018. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing. A tour of the impound lot by the Commissioners will be held.

The Noxious Weed Supt. Contract was approved in the amount of \$24,000.00. Upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke, the contract was approved. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye. Upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman the contact for road spraying with C-Weed, was approved in the amount of \$75.00 per hour. A recommendation to the Commissioners from the Deuel County Veteran's Service Committee was made to appoint Dwight Smith as Deuel County Veteran's Officer. Motion was made by Commissioner Klingman, second of Radke, to appoint Dwight Smith as Deuel County Veteran's Service Officer in the amount of \$200.00 per month. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye.

Discussion was held regarding the custodial services of the courthouse. Services will include vacuuming all three floors 2 times a week, dusting 2 times a week and 3 times a week cleaning bathrooms. An ad will be placed in the Chappell newspaper requesting interested parties to submit their bid by November 5, 2018, 4 p.m. to the Deuel County Commissioners.
