Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

November 20, 2018

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jerome Radke, County Attorney Joel Jay and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye. The minutes of the November 6, 2018 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. There was no action for the Board of Equalization.

The 2018 Audit report was received and accepted for filing in the office of the Deuel County Clerk as presented by Donald D. Wilson, C.P.A.

A general assistance burial claim was received on behalf of Miriam Nechin. After reviewing that the application meets the guidelines, motion was made by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke to approve the burial claim in the maximum amount of \$1,500.00. County Attorney Joel Jay presented information pertaining to a research invitation to obtain legal opinion regarding the distribution of funds received by the Nebraska Department of Education Lands and Funds from school land lease payments. The consensus of the Commissioners is to have County Attorney Jay contact Mr. Domina, the attorney spearheading the research project, indicating that Deuel County would be interested in proceeding depending on the costs that will be assessed to Deuel County.

Upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Radke, Deuel County will continue to contract with MAXIMUS for indirect rate computations for FY 2018 through FY 2020. Klingman, aye, Fischer, aye, Radke, aye.
