



Deuel County Board Minutes



Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

December 18, 2018

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jerome Radke, County Attorney Joel Jay and County Clerk Polly Olson, (arrived at 8:45 a.m.). The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. Radke, aye, Klingman, aye, Fischer, aye. The minutes of the November 18, 2018 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye. Commissioner Jerry Radke thanked Deuel County for the opportunity to serve Deuel County on the Board of Commissioners. Commissioner Klingman and Commissioner Fischer thanked Commissioner Radke for his service and expressed appreciation for his time and efforts.

Cheyenne County Clerk Beth Fiegenschuh is the NIRMA Chairperson. On behalf of the NIRMA Board of Directors, she presented a plaque to Deuel County in recognition of 20 years of membership in the Nebraska Inter-governmental Risk Management Association.

Deuel County Noxious Weed Supt. Cris Burkes met with the board and presented the Annual Noxious Weed Report. Upon motion of Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman, the report was reviewed and accepted for filing. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye.

Ryan Dickinson appeared before the Board stating his interest in serving as the County Surveyor. Motion to appoint Ryan Dickinson as the County Surveyor was made by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye.

A public hearing was held at 9:00 a.m. regarding the study for the closure of CR 201. Landowners and interested parties were present; Don Stretesky, his daughter and son-in law, Ray Diaz, Jimmy and Lupe Jimenez. Discussion was held regarding the access to the pumps and pivots adjoining the property. The parties indicated that they didn't have a problem with the closure as long as the access to the property through a prior easement was still in force. An attorney will assist with the easement issues. Motion of Radke, second of Klingman to close 201, commencing at the southwest corner of section 8-T12N-R42W of the 6th Principal Meridian running north for ½ mile between sections 7 and 8. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye. Motion to come out of the public meeting Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman to come out of the public hearing at 9:28, a.m.

Discussion was held regarding the itemized billing for services from Mainelli and Associates for County Highway Supt. services. It was noted that Deuel County was being charged more than the agreed upon \$500.00 per month fee. Deuel County is being charged for additional meetings. Acting Supt. Tony Armer reassured the Commissioners that he was unaware of the charges being assessed to Deuel County and he would be diligent in making sure the county was not being charged for additional items in the future. The same holds true for the zoning administration.

Motion was made by Commissioner Radke, second of Commissioner Klingman, the Grant applications for the Fair board from the Haven and Virginia Smith Trust and the Buckley Trust. Fischer, aye, Radke, aye, Klingman, aye.

A letter of interest in serving on the Deuel County fair board was received of Haley Magee. Upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, Haley Magee will be appointed to the Deuel County fair board to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Patrick Ningen. Radke, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye.



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Discussion was held regarding a law suit filed against Deuel County by Frenchman Valley Cooperative Assn. pertaining to denial of a request for refund of taxes. This refund was denied during the November 6, 2018 Commissioner meeting. The information has been forwarded to NIRMA for special consultation.

The quarterly safety committee meeting was held. One accident was reported on CR 171.

County Clerk, Clerk of the District Court Polly Olson presented a report of fees collected in the amount of \$5,015.38, collected in the month of November, 2018, was reviewed and accepted for filing.

Warrants in the amount of \$87,582.67, were approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Radke, (Payroll \$26,517.04, Claims \$61,065.63), Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Radke, aye.
