



Deuel County Board Minutes



Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

May 7, 2019

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm, County Attorney Joel Jay, County Clerk Polly Olson and Deputy County Clerk Tammy Sherman. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. The minutes of the April 16, 2019 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman. Fischer, aye, Timm, aye, Klingman, aye.

No action for the Board of Equalization.

County Clerk Polly Olson presented a report of fees collected for the month of April in the amount of \$1,677.95. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing.

Jerry Fiest met with the board to present the annual Predator control inter-local agreement with the USDA and requests that the county again participate in the program. Discussion was held regarding the services offered to the county residents and who pays what portion of the fees. He introduced Jeremy Kral as the individual who provides the services in Deuel County. Upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Fischer, Deuel County will continue to participate in inter-local agreement for predatory animal control. Timm, aye, Klingman, aye, Fischer, aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman, to approve the special designate permit for a wedding reception to be held on the Deuel County fairgrounds on June 29, 2019. Fischer, aye, Timm, aye, Klingman, aye.

A letter of resignation, effective May 15, 2019, was received of Joel Jay who will be appointed as County Judge for the 11th Judicial District. Upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, the resignation was accepted with regret. Timm, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye. Deputy Garden County Attorney Rory Roundtree, his secretary Becky Hunt, Morrill County Attorney Travis Rodak and Attorney J. Leef were present during the discussion of an interim appointment during the process. An offer was made by the Garden County Attorney office to provide interim services in the amount of \$3,550.00 a month plus mileage for both Rory Roundtree and Phil Pierce, \$28.00 per hour plus mileage for the office administrator, Becky Hunt. The agreement will be valid until July 15, but can be discontinued sooner if a replacement has been found. Motion was made by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm, to accept the offer as presented by Mr. Roundtree. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. Options available to appoint a replacement for the county attorney position was a topic of discussion. Upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm, a special meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 14, 2019 at 8:30 a.m. for the purpose of conducting interviews with the attorneys interested in being appointed as Deuel County Attorney. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Timm to contract with Mark Mainelli to provide the necessary services to conduct the required bridge inspections on bridges within Deuel County at a cost of \$150.00 per bridge (17). Klingman, aye, Fischer, aye, Timm, aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, to hire Carl Snell as a part-time employee to work 20 weeks maximum, 20 hours per week at \$15.00 per hour beginning May 28, 2019.



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Deuel County Sheriff Scott DeCoste presented a report of fees collected for the month of April in the amount of \$224.62. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing. Motion was made by Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman, to approve the grant application to the Buckley Trustees for the school resource officer. The officer would be shared between the county, Creek Valley Schools and South Platte Schools. Fischer, aye, Timm, aye, Klingman, aye.
