Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

March 19, 2019

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner Jean Timm, County Attorney Joel Jay and County Clerk Polly Olson. Commissioner William Klingman was excused and absent. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Fischer. Klingman, absent, Fischer, aye, Timm, aye. The minutes of the March 5, 2019 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Timm. No action for the Board of Equalization.

No action was taken regarding the personal property that the Sandpoint Company indicated they own on the sale barn property.

A clarification to the Deuel County employee handbook was made. Vacation time will be accrued and five days will be allowed to carry over.

Office Administrator Chauntine Snell and Highway Supervisor Kelly Kopetzky met with the board to discuss the operations of the highway department and to approve employing a part-time temporary person to assist with mowing from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Timm to approve hiring a part-time, temporary employee to work 20 hours per week, \$15.00 per hour. Applications will be due April 9. County Sheriff Scott DeCoste discussed the Sheriff inter-local agreements for law enforcement. The County Commissioners will meet with the Trustees of the Village of Big Springs on Tuesday, April 2, 2019 at 4:30 in Big Springs at the Village Meeting room to discuss the agreement.
