Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

May 22, 2019

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm, Rory Roundtree and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. The minutes of the May 14, 2019 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman. Fischer, aye, Timm, aye, Klingman, aye.

No action for the Board of Equalization.

The board received a notice, (for informational purposes only), of the lump sum settlement for the workman's compensation claim of Michael Hutchinson received from the Nebraska Intergovernmental Risk Management Association. After review, the board approved the information pertaining to the lump sum settlement agreement upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye.

Sheriff Scott DeCoste presented information pertaining to the inter-local agreement for the school resource officer. Also present for this topic was Patrick Ningen and Tessa Fraas from Creek Valley Schools. It was reported that representatives from the Creek Valley Schools, South Platte Schools and the Deuel County Sheriff Dept. applied for a Buckley Trust grant for this position and it the trustees approved a single grant in the amount of \$30,000.00 that could be applied for annually, for this purpose. Contingent upon all three entities participating in the inter-local. Discussion was held regarding whether a new person would be hired to be in this position or if a current employee could become the resource officer. This item will be on the June 4 agenda.

The law enforcement inter-local agreement between Deuel County and the Village of Big Springs was approved and signed as received upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman. Fischer, aye, Timm, aye, Klingman, aye.

Cal Strong of Arthur J. Gallagher & Co. presented information pertaining to the 2019-2020 employee insurance coverage. Comparisons were made to the current policy coverage (which is no longer available) and the ones closest to our policy. It was determined that the Alternate BluePride policy would be the best for the employees and the budget of Deuel County. Upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, the County will renew the employee insurance coverage with Blue Cross Blue Shield of Nebraska, BluePride GPA19 Gold, deductible of \$1,000.00 single/\$2,000.00 family, with Arthur J. Gallagher & Co. The County will buy back \$500.00 of the employee deductible. Timm, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, to approve a propane contract, 5,000 gallons, to be prepaid. Office Administrator Chauntine Snell will contact Frenchman Valley to get the contract updated. Timm, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye. Discussion was held regarding the NIRMA recommended hydraulic study of the county culverts. Upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm, the board will let bids for hydraulic studies of the culverts in Deuel County. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. Bids for this project will be opened on June 4, 2019 at 9:00 a.m.

Motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, to enter into executive session for the purpose of negotiations for the county attorney position at 9:44 a.m. with the following present: Commissioners Fischer, Klingman, Timm, County Attorney Jay, County Clerk Olson and County Sheriff DeCoste and Deputy Jerod Hahn. 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Motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Timm, to resume the regular meeting at 10:57 a.m. Klingman, aye, Fischer, aye, Timm, aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, to resume the regular meeting at 12:13 p.m.

Motion was made by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm, to appoint Jonathon Stellar as County Attorney and accept the proposal of \$88,950.00, annually to operate the office including his salary, for the remainder of the term. Start date is projected as June 1, 2019 contingent upon scheduling. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye.
