Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

August 20, 2019

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm, County Attorney Jonathon Stellar and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. The minutes of the August 6, 2019 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. No action for the Board of Equalization.

Upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman, Resolution 2019-1, Fire District #1 Tax request of \$54,880.00, to fall under County levy allocation, was denied. No action was taken for a proposed resolution from Terry Jessen regarding real estate taxes in Nebraska.

Discussion was held regarding a claim from Sandpoint in the amount of \$10,000.00. County Attorney Stellar will reach out to the company to discuss this subject.

Rachel Smith with Rauner and Associates was present during the budget workshop. Two funds have not submitted their request yet. The procedure for transfers was discussed. A resolution will still be presented for the transfer to the highway dept. from county general, other transfers will be made by a claim to leave a paper trail within the claims. To try to prevent negative fund balance in the fair fund, improvements to the buildings will now be within the building and grounds as a line item. The same will hold for the impound lot.

Discussion was held regarding hiring another highway laborer. Motion was made by Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman, to interview the top four applicants. Fischer, aye, Timm, aye, Klingman, aye. Interviews will take place on Thursday with one Commissioner present. The position is to be filled during the Sept. 3, Commissioner meeting.
