Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

March 17, 2020

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Sheriff Scott DeCoste reported on activities within his office. Interviews are being conducted to fill the deputy vacancy. Sheriff DeCoste praised the area fire departments for getting ahead of the fires that threatened the city of Chappell. Leslie Snell, who has been hired as the office administrator for the sheriff office, has been doing a good job learning the procedures of the office. He also reported fees collected by his office in the amount of \$448.12. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing.

Judd Allen and Doug Leafgreen with Blue Cross Blue Shield met with the board to discuss the BCBS NACO group rates. NACO benefit services. Services that are offered through the benefit services were presented. The rates would be composite instead of age related. Coverage available would also be compared with the current plan through B.C.B.S. The deductible would carry forward to the new plan without penalty to the employee.
