Commissioner Meeting

April 7, 2020

Teleconference as per Governor Ricketts Executive Order No. 20-03

The Deuel County Commissioners met via teleconference on the above date with the following officials participating: Chairperson Steven Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm, County Attorney Jonathon Stellar, County Assessor Marica Schivelbein, County Sheriff Scott DeCoste, County Treasurer Bernadette Littlejohn, County Highway Supt. Tony Armer, Highway Supervisor Kelly Kopetzky, Officer Administrator Chauntine Snell and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm, with the following cancellations: Safety Committee meeting, including Chad Engle of NIRMA and BCBS rates. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. Motion was made by Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman, to approve the regular minutes of the March 17, 2020 meeting and the April 1, 2020 special teleconference minutes. Fischer, aye, Timm, aye, Klingman, aye.

County Clerk Polly Olson presented a report of fees collected in the amount of \$1,078.97 for the month of April, 2020. This report had been sent via email, was reviewed and accepted for filing.

There was no action for the Board of Equalization.

Highway Supervisor Kelly Kopetzky was instructed to purchase the chemical needed to spray sandbur.

County Attorney Jonathon Stellar discussed offering a "hazardous duty pay" during this time to the Sheriff and deputies. He expressed that there was room in the jail budget to provide for this in the amount of \$200.00 per month to each law enforcement officer. Commissioner Klingman was not opposed. Commissioner Timm suggested that the subject may be addressed during the employee pay raises to be conducted in July or part of the longevity pay at the end of the year. Commissioner Fischer requested that Attorney Stellar obtain more information of how other counties are handling this topic and the legal issues it may ensue. This item will be discussed during the April 21 teleconference.

Clint Koenen representing the Chappell Livestock Committee answered questions pertaining to the Sheep and Goat barn to be built on the fairground property. He reported that the old building had been removed, the rest was waiting for bid approval to begin construction. He reported that the grant money had been obtained, the majority from the Buckley Trust. It was moved by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm, to accept the bid from VAP construction in the amount of \$24,420.00. The livestock committee will make the initial down payment. Half will be due when supplies are delivered. Construction is to be completed by July 1, 2020 at which time the balance will be paid. The fair board will be requested to submit the claims for payment.

Motion was made by commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm to approve claims in the amount of \$118,051.66, (Payroll \$32,850.56 and claims \$85,201.10). Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye.
