



# Deuel County Board Minutes



Commissioner Meeting

April 21, 2020

Teleconference as per Governor Ricketts Executive Order No. 20-03

The Deuel County Commissioners met via teleconference on the above date with the following officials participating: Chairperson Steven Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm, County Attorney Jonathon Stellar and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm . Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. Motion was made by Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman, to approve the regular minutes of the April 7 ,2020 meeting. Fischer, aye, Timm, aye, Klingman, aye.

There was no action for the Board of Equalization.

Road and Bridge supervisor Kelly Kopetzky and Office Administrator Chauntine Snell requested clarification of the 4-10 hour work days on the 3rd of July. The July 4th holiday is observed the 3rd of July, a Friday which is the day off for the road laborers during the 4-10 hour shifts. The road laborers are instructed to stagger the holiday, some will have off Thursday preceding the holiday and the others Monday after the holiday, ensuring that someone is working on both the Thursday and Monday and not all gone on both days. Employees are encouraged to wear the masks provided by the county when in vehicles together and they are not able to keep 6 foot of distance within the work space. It was reported that 8 tons of cold mix only completed 2 miles of the Day Road, which in the past could cover filling the pot holes on the whole road. Maintenance was discussed for the road by the Flying J (formerly Bosselman's ) in Big Springs. This road was removed from the county one and six in 2007, when the Village of Big Springs annexed the property. This portion of road maintenance became under the jurisdiction of the Village of Big Springs at that time.

Sheriff DeCoste reported on activities within his office. He reported that new locks are installed on every door. A key fob or key card will be issued to each employee. He reported that the doors will be programmed to automatically open at 7:59 a.m. and close at 4:00 p.m. If electricity goes out, the generator should provide power.

County Attorney Jonathon Stellar discussed offering a "hazardous duty pay" during this time to the Sheriff and deputies. He has not received information from his request of NIRMA at this time. He reported that this is being done in larger agencies in the East. It may be for 6-9 months. More information will be obtained and presented to the board.

Assessor Marica Schievelbein reported that a TERC Show Cause hearing will be held for Deuel County on April 29, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. Dryland should be at 72% of actual value and is currently at 79%.

Motion was made by commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm to approve claims in the amount of \$81,791.45, (Payroll \$28,520.05 and claims \$ 53,271.40). Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye.
