Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

May 19, 2020

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. Due to COVID restrictions and the ten person meeting recommendation the public was invited to attend via uber teleconference. The agenda was approved, with an amendment that two zoning permits will need approval, upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. The minutes of the May 5, 2020 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye.

There was no action for the Board of Equalization.

Discussion was held regarding the Day Road. Highway Supt. Tony Armer suggested that the county purchase a paving machine and contract out the additional laborers needed to complete the projects. It was requested that a compilation of what the actual costs to the county would be doing this versus having a company come in and provide services. The board indicated that they do not want to establish an extra levy to complete the repairs.

The updates to the Local Emergency Operations Plan (LEOP) were previously received via email from Region 21 Emergency Manager Ron Leal. It was moved by Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman to approve the LEOP Resolution. Fischer, aye, Timm, aye, Klingman, aye.

Two building permits were approved at a zoning meeting held May 18. They were presented for approval. A building permit for Barry Walker 1-17 and Arlene Penner 1-18, were approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye.

A budget request from the Sandhills Crisis Intervention Program, SCIP, was received in the amount of \$2,000.00. Upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, Deuel County will provide \$1,500.00 as previous budget years to SCIP. Timm, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye.

Discussion was held regarding plans to re-open the county courthouse. The recommendation is to open May 20, 2020 at 8:00 a.m., masks are recommended, social distancing of six feet is required, hand sanitizer will be available at each entrance and limited access to each office (one at a time). Each office will be in charge of their individual protocols. Motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman to approve the recommendation.
