Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

June 23, 2020

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm, and County Clerk Polly Olson at 8:30 a.m. Upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman, the meeting will recess until 1:00 p.m. due to a unforeseen scheduling conflict. Fischer, excused, Timm, aye, Klingman, aye. At 1:00 p.m. the following officials are present: Chairperson Steven Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm, County Attorney Jonathon Stellar and County Clerk Polly Olson. Motion was made by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm to reconvene the regular meeting. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. The minutes of the June 2 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman. Fischer, aye, Timm, aye, Klingman, aye.

There was no action for the Board of Equalization.

Richard and Betty O'Bannion, owners of the property located South of the Deuel County Annex on Vincent met with the board. The roof of their property had recently blown off during a storm and they are requesting assistance in repairing the adjoining wall that has a crack running from the floor to ceiling. They also would like to have the drainage at the West end of the buildings be inspected. Maintenance contractor Jim Reichman will be contacted to inspect the buildings and give recommendation at the July 7 meeting.

County Highway Supervisor Kelly Kopetzky, Office Administrator Chauntine Snell and County Highway Supt. Tony Armer were present to discuss the operations of the highway dept. Also present was Keith County Commissioner Tony Krajewski and Garden County Highway Supt. Gerald Frerichs. County Highway Supt. Tony Armer presented the bid specifications and engineering contract from Mainelli and Wagner for the Day Road , Project #C-25(46), C-25(47), C-25(53). The cost of the contract includes plans for the road and continuous inspection as the projects are being completed and are about 10% of the entire project. Mr. Krajewski offered another option, using Baker and Associates who are located in Scottsbluff. The Board requested that this bid be placed on the July 7 agenda for review and possible approval.

Fair board member Leslie Snell met with the board to discuss the 2020 Deuel County Fair. She gave an update of the entertainment contracts and the deposits that had already been made for 2021. Those have been moved to 2022. There will be no open class or food stands. 4-H and Livestock will be allowed. A plan has been submitted to the Panhandle Public Health Dept. for approval.

Sheriff Scott DeCoste reported on activities within his office. The public auction of abandoned vehicles will be July 18.

Discussion was held regarding pay increases. It was moved by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm, to enter into executive session to discuss employee evaluations at 2:45 p.m. with the Commissioners present and Kelly Kopetzky. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye.

Upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, the board resumed the regular meeting at 3:13 p.m. Timm, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye. It was moved by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm to set the following payroll policy for budget year 2020-2021. There will be no longevity pay this year. Each road employee will receive pay in the following amounts. Road Supervisor Kelly Kopetzky \$42,640.00 (\$20.50 per hour),

Office Administrator \$30,030.00, (\$16.50 per hour).
