



# Deuel County Board Minutes



Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

August 4, 2020

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm, County Attorney Jonathon Stellar and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. The minutes of the July 21, 2020 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman. Fischer, aye, Timm, aye, bubble, Klingman, aye.

County Clerk Polly Olson presented a report of fees collected in the office for the month of July, 2020, in the amount of \$1,586.47. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing.

There was no action for the Board of Equalization.

Rental policies and procedures for the Deuel County Fairgrounds were discussed. Fair board member Leslie Snell was present to answer any questions. The Commissioners requested that no private gatherings be allowed at this time, to follow with the health directives from the Governor. For the time being, wedding receptions that have been scheduled will be allowed, nothing else. The County does not promote large gatherings and nothing will receive approval without the guidance of the Panhandle Health Department (PHD). PHD receives and reviews the event plans prior to scheduling. County Attorney Stellar will provide an attachment for the fair board to be included with the applications to rent the county owned facility. County liability issues were discussed. If alcohol is consumed on public property, (regardless if sold or not), a special designate permit, from the Liquor Control Commission, must be obtained (NRS 53-124.11). Prior approval for the special designated permit must be obtained from the Commissioners and the Sheriff. The fair activities scheduled for the 4-H youth have obtained prior approval from PHD, using the health directives used as guidance.

Resolution 2020-1 from the Chappell Rural Fire District #1 in the amount of \$56,801.00, requesting levy allocation from the Deuel County Board of Commissioners is reviewed and upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm, is denied. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. Resolution 2020-1, from the Big Springs Rural Fire District #2, requesting levy allocation in the amount of \$84,547.91, was also reviewed and denied upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. This allows each rural board to set their own levy authority for fiscal year 2020-2021, within the statutory guidelines.

Discussion was held regarding the activities within the highway dept. Present to answer questions were office administrator Chauntine Snell and highway supervisor Kelly Kopetzky. It was also noted that the approval of the bid specifications for publication will be reviewed during the August 18 meeting.

Sheriff Scott DeCoste presented a report of fees collected by his office in the amount of \$81.45 for the month of July, 2020. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing.

The budget document was reviewed as prepared by C.P.A. Rachel Smith. The 2020 Budget Hearing is scheduled for September 15, 2020.

Warrants in the amount of \$111,843.05, were approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Fischer, (Payroll \$33,305.06, Claims \$78,537.99), Klingman, aye. Timm, aye, Fischer, aye.
