Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

October 6, 2020

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm, County Attorney Jonathon Stellar and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. The minutes of the September 15, 2020 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman. Motion was made by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm, to enter into the Board of Equalization to hear tax list corrections at 8:32 a.m. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman, to approve the Pritchard and Abbott contract with the Deuel County Assessor for oil and gas appraisals. Fischer, aye, Timm, aye, Klingman, aye.

The response to audit findings were discussed. County Attorney Stellar will draft a response on behalf of the rental of the fairground facility. The County Treasurer has already responded as well as the County Clerk. These items and the management representation letter will be further discussed during the next commissioner meeting.

County Clerk Polly Olson presented a report of fees collected in the amount of \$1,779.96, for the month of September, 2020. This report was reviewed and accepted for filing.

Operations of the highway dept. were discussed. Resolution 2020-15, the Annual Certification of Program Compliance was approved upon motion of commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. D & J Paving requested approval to begin crack sealing road 167 south of Chappell without a bond. Companies that work on county roads must provide a bond prior to any work commencing.
