



Deuel County Board Minutes



Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

November 17, 2020

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm, County Attorney Jonathon Stellar and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Fischer. Timm, aye, Klingman, aye, Fischer, aye. The minutes of the November 3, 2020 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman. Timm, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, no.

No action was taken for the Board of Equalization.

Operations of the highway dept. were discussed. Resolution 2020-18, the Year-end certification of Highway Superintendent was approved upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Timm. Klingman, aye, Fischer, aye, Timm, aye. Discussion was held regarding the installation of a culvert for Barry Johnson of Big Springs. It appears that there is a need as run-off from the county shop property may be causing the issue. The landowner will purchase the culvert and the county will place it. The county will also clean out the culverts on either side to ensure that there is no blockage.

Noxious Weed Supt. Cris Burkes presented the annual Noxious Weed Report that will be submitted to the state. Upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm, this report was reviewed and accepted for filing. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye.

John Bender of Frenchman Valley Coop was present during a discussion regarding the omitted taxes for the tank for the years it was not on the tax rolls. There is no statute of limitation on omitted taxes. County Attorney Stellar reported that the NIRMA attorney would like to discuss any further potential suits with FVC attorney. The Commissioners indicated that they had no concerns with the two attorneys communicating regarding the issues at hand.

Sheriff Scott DeCoste discussed the activities within his office. In conclusion of the research from the last meeting, he reported that the two pickups he was considering buying for his department were as follows: a Ford in the amount of \$38,500.00 and Dodge in the amount of \$35,000.00. Neither will be available until May of 2021. He reported that he has decided to purchase the Dodge.

Upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman, the annual Agreement between the Administrative Office of the Courts and Probation (AOCP) and Deuel County was approved. Fischer, aye, Timm, aye, Klingman, aye.

Don Lease and Tami Whited presented information via telephone on behalf of Nebraska Strong. This organization provides crisis counseling during the pandemic. They are funded through a grant program of Region one and are here to serve the needs in the area. Handouts and flyers have been distributed in the community and are available at the courthouse.

Motion was made by Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, to enter into executive session at 9:31 a.m. with Commissioners Steven Fischer, William Klingman, Jean Timm, County Attorney Jonathon Stellar, Road Supt. Tony Armer and Road Supervisor Kelly Kopetzky to discuss personnel items. Timm, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye.
