



Deuel County Board Minutes



Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

January 19, 2021

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm, County Attorney Jonathon Stellar and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. The minutes of the January 5, 2021 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman. Timm, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye.

Bernie Littlejohn, Deuel County Treasurer presented the Six Month report. After review, motion by Timm, seconded by Klingman to approve the report and accept for filing. Fischer, Aye, Timm, Aye and Klingman Aye.

Highway Supt. Tony Armer, presented the job posting for the Highway Superintendent position to the Board for review. The job will be posted in the January 19 Chappell paper, the applications will be due February 1 2021. A copy of the job posting will be filed in the Clerk’s office and the start date will depend on the applications. Discussion was held regarding discontinuing the contract with Mainelli, Wagner and Associates for Highway Supt. Services. This will be on the agenda during the February 2, regular meeting. A motion by Klingman, seconded by Timm to approve the job posting; Fischer, Aye; Klingman, Aye, and Timm, Aye; motion approved.

A short discussion was held concerning a vehicle for the Highway Superintendent; Highway Supt. Armer has found a 2016 or 2017 single cab F150 4x4 Game and Parks pickup that will be available shortly. It has approximately 89,000 miles for a cost of \$8,400. The Board approved the purchase from Game and Parks Department. Mr. Armer advised the cracking sealing job is finished and a claim will be submitted at the next meeting.

Sheriff Scott DeCoste reported on activities within his office.

Representatives of Nebraska Strong presented information regarding the duties and responsibilities of Nebraska Strong. Emphasized that they are willing to help and are really trying to work with the nursing homes. FEMA sponsors Nebraska Strong. The current project is Random Acts of Kindness Day, February 17, 2021. They commended the schools and ambulance service in the local area for their willingness and stamina to keep open and working.

Warrants in the amount of \$128,352.97, were approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. (Payroll \$32,095.81, Claims \$96,257.16 Fischer, Aye; Klingman, Aye; Timm, Aye; motion approved.

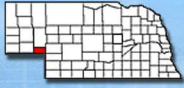
