Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

June 15, 2021

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. The minutes of the June 1, 2021 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Fischer. Klingman, aye, Timm, aye, Fischer, aye.

Upon motion of Commissioner Fischer, second of Commissioner Klingman, the board entered into the Board of Equalization to hear Permissive Exemptions at 8:33 a.m. Timm, aye, Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye.

Motion was made by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Fischer, to reconvene the regular meeting at 8:40 a.m. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye.

Operations of the highway department were discussed. It was reported that the paving was finished on the Day Road, striping will be done next week, "bump" specifications will be completed in the fall.

The Memorandum of Understanding between Deuel County and the American Red Cross was reviewed. This item will be placed on the July 6 board meeting when Emergency Manager Ron Leal can be in attendance.

Discussion was held regarding the potential use of Recovery Act Plan funds. A request has been received from the Panhandle Public Health Department for 7% of the funds to support services for continued response to the pandemic. No action was taken at this time.

Motion was made by Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm, to approve the transfer of budget authority from General Miscellaneous to Veteran's Service Office in the amount of \$18.34. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye.
