Deuel County Commissioner Meeting

February 15, 2022

The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date with the following officials present: Chairperson Steve Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm, County Assessor Michele Bartlett, County Treasurer Alicia Adams, County Attorney Jonathon Stellar and County Clerk Polly Olson. The meeting, notice of which was published in the Chappell Register as according to law, was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence. Reference was made to open meeting laws, posted at the entrance of the room. The agenda was approved upon motion of Commissioner Klingman, second of Commissioner Timm. Fischer, aye, Klingman, aye, Timm, aye. The minutes of the February 1, 2022 meeting were approved upon motion of Commissioner Timm, second of Commissioner Klingman. During public comment, Aaron Stegeman requested that the county consider doing something to take care of the ice accumulation that occurs each winter. The ice extends from the north side of the courthouse, across the alley and into his back yard, making it treacherous to access the dumpster.

Extension Educator for Rural Prosperity Nebraska, (RPN), Jaime Bright, met with the board to introduce herself and give an overview of how she helps with Community Development within the region.

Operations of the highway department were discussed. Highway Supt. Anthony Armer reported that the county FCC license had expired. It is unknown how this affects the county as the radios have not been used for some time. He asked if there was even a reason the county needed to have the license. The board left it up to his discretion.
