The Deuel County Commissioners met on the above date at 1:30 PM with the following present: Chairperson Steven Fischer, Commissioner William Klingman, Commissioner Jean Timm, County Attorney Jon Stellar, Hwy Superintendent Anthony Armer, Jared Elms and Clerk Tammy Sherman. Fischer called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and moment of silence.
